KITCHEN & GARAGE EXTENSION AT ABOVE ADDRESS.

Whilst digging a hole for the construction of a manhole in my front garden I found running parallel, about 18" from my soil pipe at the same depth, an 8" cast iron pipe which is not in any way part of my property.

When I reported my findings to you, the Building Inspectors Department, I was told by you in conjunction with your Drainage Department that this was your pipe and it was an 8" rising sewage pipe from the Chelmsford Road and that it was in order for me to carry on with my extension on top of the pipe and that it would in no way affect either pipe or extension.

I would like from you in writing your consent that it is in order for me to carry on with the building and that you accept responsibility for any damage that may arise to either pipe or to the extension if the damage to the extension is caused by the pipe fracturing.
