THE Council did not send out a letter therefore we were not consulted. The housing development at the roundabout came to our attention on Monday 21st when we saw the hoardings erected and Weston-homes signs advising that 85 homes were to be built soon. I called the council offices after trying unsuccessfully for sometime to find information on the Planning web site. They first of all gave me a Waverley planning number. Several calls later and I was given 14/01446/EIA. A ward councillor gave me printed copies of the application. We then learned that Chainbridge Farm has been put forward to the local plan for housing and neighbours told me it was in the Sheffield library.

We object most strongly to both developments. Chainbridge is surrounded by our farmland and is in Green Belt. Our private farm road is the only access from Roman Road and is in constant use by heavy farm machinery.
