CEG Land Promotions have not undertaken a full review of the council's evidence on development equirements but as a matter of principle it would always be wise to recognise that development equirements can alter quickly and substantially. For example, changes in household projections, by requirements, affordability and housing market signals can often be the catalyst for increased lousing requirements. CEG will be considering these matters further.						
n such circumstances, we would recommend that the policies relevant to housing in particular emain as flexible as possible and constantly under review. At the very least, policy 5.2 should be amended to ensure the provision of 7,240 new homes in the plan period and the annual average of 162 homes is recognised as a minimum. We suggest an amendment to the first paragraph as collows:						
Provision is made for a minimum of 7,240 new residential dwellings (net) to be built in the borough over the plan period 2013-2033 at a minimum annual average rate of 362 dwellings per year as ollows"
