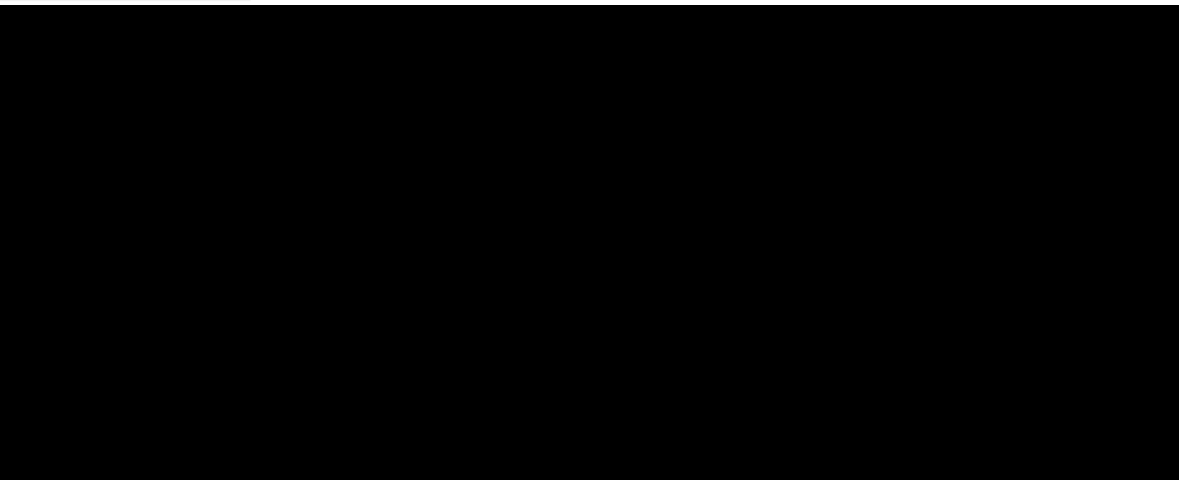

CEG support the target for providing 5,000 additional jobs in the Borough during the plan period.

We note that job growth is expected to be distributed primarily through new employment (B-use) and the allocation of at least 5 hectares of employment land at Dunton Hills Garden Village will make a contribution towards this.

We also support the recognition in policy 5.3 that other business sectors will support job growth over the Plan period. Dunton Hills Garden Village as a self-sustaining community will provide a substantial number of additional jobs in the local retail, education and health facilities.

It is estimated that Dunton Garden Village will itself create circa 5,000 jobs including approximately 1,200 construction jobs.
