Green Belt land in Ingrave

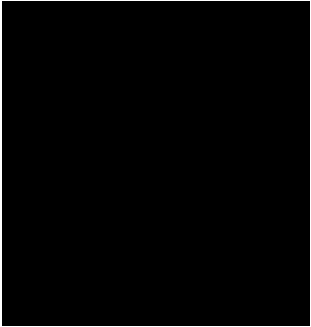
