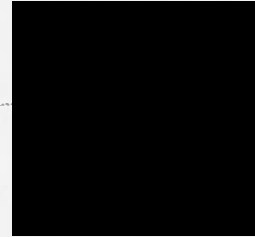

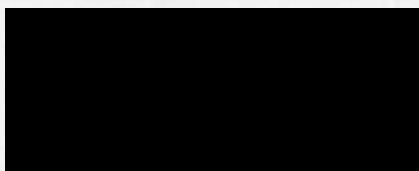
Dear Mr Geisa

Thank you for your letter of 18th November and photographs of a neighbouring building project for which I would firstly like to apologise for the delay in replying to you.

Although the photographs do not make it clear, I believe that the property in question lies within the residentially allocated part of Rector Chase. As you are aware, in the 1995 Local Plan, your property lies in the Green Belt. However, as you are also aware, in the Replacement Local Plan it is proposed to include your dwelling within that same residential area.

Whilst each planning application stands to be determined on its own merits, clearly the allocation of the property in the Local Plan at the relevant time is a strong determining factor in the process and, in particular, the relevant policies relating to that land use allocation.
