Proposed development OH4 and 178
Land at Priests Lane.

I am surprised that it is necessary for more letters of protest to be written, but it seems that you still have not accepted the stupidity and lack of common sense behind the proposed development.

By allowing 95 new homes to be built on the site, some additional 130-180 vehicles will need to be parked, and will add to the already overcrowded roads in the Priests Lane area. The junction of Ingrave Road and Middleton Hall Lane is already overstretched at peak times, and extra vehicles will make the junction unbearable. There was an accident in Shenfield present last week, due to the heavy traffic collecting children from school, and more accidents can be expected, putting the childrens safety at risk. On 5th March an emergency ambulance was called for a resident in Shenfield present, arriving at 3pm.

Valuable time was lost, as the ambulance was unable to leave for hospital because the road was totally blocked with school traffic.

With the additional residents, how will the already over crowded doctors surgeries and schools cope?

Surely by now you can see the stupidity of allowing further development in this area and reject the application,
