To The Planning Officers,

I cannot agree to development on either of these sites. Blackmore does not have the infrastructure to support or cope with the demands that will be made.

1. The village has little enough parking as it is trying to support the locals and visitors alike.
2. How will the local stations deal with the extra demands being made on them by the influx of cars.
3. There is one SMALL general store in the village (it also houses the post office), which will struggle severely trying to serve these development.
