- BBC have not demonstrated there are other brownfield sites available.
- There are more Suitable and Sustainable locations i.e The Urban Extension to Brentwood. The Blackmore locations do not promote Sustainable development considering the limited available facilities.
- BBC have not published a clear "Stralegy" for the villages in the North of the Borough including Blackmore.
- No Housing Needs Survey has been done to show why Blackmore is included in the LDP.
  - But have failed to demonstrate that the required housing could not be met by increasing the housing density on other Browfield or Allocated siles.
  - There are other Drownfield Siles available which should take priority over Greenfield and Greenbelt land which Blocare aware of.
- BBC have failed to consider the impact on Blackmore of the proposed 20 dwellings off Fingrith Hall Lane, with BBC failing to Consult Epping forest District Council.
- Blackmore is an isolated village and road access has not been designed to meet the number of cars without mentioning the heavy rehicles required to build the number of houses in the LDP.
- With heavy snow which we have seen very recently the village is cut of for days with roads that are in passable.
- All proposed sites in Blackmore will be liable to flooding therefore building on this land will no doubt increase this probability which with could result in the village potentially flooding which would greatly impact the current residents.
- INADEQUATE SERVICES AVAILABLE There is only I BP surgery covering 5 villages which are all being impacted by the LDP. Bus facilities are by no means adequate at the current time voithout the extra residents in proposed houses. Please continue on a separate sheet if necessary

The local schools are running at full capacity contrently so the "extra children" would have to be schooled outside of the village thus creating more traffic and pollution.
