We are supportive of this policy, which promotes the use of SuDS following the preferred hierarchy of surface water drainage. The supporting text notes that sewage infrastructure in the north of the Borough is operating at full capacity, and we therefore particularly support standard 'e. redeveloped brownfield sites should disconnect any surface water drainage from the foul network.'

However, while we are pleased to note that paragraph 4.166 of the justification for this policy includes reference to the Water Framework Directive, we recommend that a more positive description is given to the benefits afforded by the Directive. While some water bodies have been heavily modified and may never revert entirely back to their natural state, the Directive still aims for them to achieve good ecological potential.
